The Slope Electric board convenes once a month to discuss and decide on matters crucial to our cooperative's operations, development and growth.

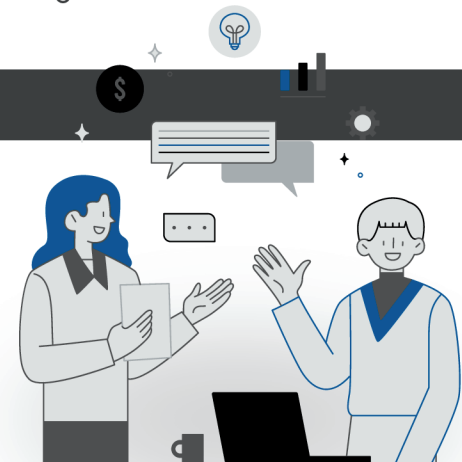


TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES
